- Committee member issues Peer-Review Report within 14 days
- Original interpretation rated on severity, conspicuity and impact on patient care
- Verbal notification made if a significant miss impacting patient care is identified
- Client reports accessible online at any time in ν Rad's online Order Management System (OMS)
